

Christmas Bauble Competition

Healthy Eating & Drinking Policy – A reminder about playtime snacks and drinks

Our school's Healthy Eating & Drinking Policy follows the Government's statutory guidance on food in schools:

- All pupils under 5 and children who receive free school meals are entitled to free milk which is provided in school.
- We also offer other pupils milk on a daily basis through the subsidised milk scheme for which there is a charge.
- All Foundation Stage and KS1 classes are provided with fruit and vegetables at morning break under the Government Initiative to provide free fruit and vegetables during the day.
- KS2 children are encouraged to bring a snack at playtime, consisting of a piece of fresh fruit or vegetable (or uncoated dried fruit). Parents of children with special dietary needs are encouraged to discuss this with staff. No nuts will be allowed.
- All children are strongly encouraged to bring their own container to school and to actually drink water regularly. Cooled water is freely available throughout the school day to all members of the school community. Flavoured waters and squashes are discouraged in line with DFE Food Standards permitted drinks. (Guidance: School food standards practical guide - Updated 11 May 2022)
