FABULOUS FRIDAY CLUB – FOR YEAR 6 CHILDREN AND THEIR PARENTS & CARERS

In order to support your child's learning, Mr Cockburn will be running a weekly 'Fabulous Friday' club from 8.30 – 9.30, with support from other members of staff. Parents, Carers or Grandparents are invited to work together with pupils, whilst Mr Cockburn leads maths and literacy sessions in the school hall.

We really appreciate that children's confidence, progress and attainment improves when a partnership exists at home, when parents/carers can support learning. If parents and carers can attend part or all of the sessions, that would be a great benefit, even if it's just for 10 or 15 minutes.

The weekly sessions will start on **Friday 19th January at 8:30** and run until the statutory tests in May. It is hoped that all pupils will be able to attend at that time. We understand that school transport children may arrive slightly later.

The school does appreciate, that for some parents, these times may prove challenging but you may be in a position to attend some of the sessions or even part of them. When we last ran these workshops they were very well received and we anticipate a similar response this year.

Y6 children should arrive at school at 8.20 (bus children to come to the hall as soon as they arrive – if after 8.30) and enter the building via the Year 1 corridor. Please put coats and bags in the Year 6 classroom and be in the hall at 8.30, prompt, ready to begin.
